Keeping your Smartphone Safe

With so many people using iPhones, Androids, Blackberries, etc. more and more of your information is stored on your smartphones. You need to remember to protect your phone to keep others from stealing your info. There are several things you can do to help secure your phone.

First, create a power on password that is easier than 1111 or 1234. Make it hard to guess and hard for someone to watch over your shoulder and learn your password.

Next, set your phone to lock after a certain period of inactivity. If you are not using your phone, no one can just pick it up, read your emails, look through your calendar, etc.

And perform a backup/synchronization on a regular basis. Just like your PC, backup your phone so if it is damaged or stolen, you can retrieve your information.

Also, be careful about downloading all the latest and greatest apps. They can carry Trojan horses with them that can infect your phone and give others access to it.

If you need to send attachments to someone, please remember to use a type of file that they can open or view. Not everyone has Office 2007, or Publisher, Word Perfect (yes, people still use Word Perfect). If you are sending an image, please use a JPG format. It is a universal format and easy for everyone to open. If you need to send a document or brochure, use Adobe Acrobat's PDF format. If you don't have the full version of Adobe Acrobat, you can use free utilities like PrimoPDF to convert your Publisher files, Word documents, etc. to PDFs.
